ANNOUNCEMENT

The MTÜ Redmoto will promote the 3rd round of the 2021 FIM Enduro World Championship on behalf of the Estonian Motorcycling Federation (EMF).

The event will be held in accordance with the Sporting Code of the FIM together with the relevant Appendices, these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions approved by the FIM Race Direction.

The event will be held on 16-18 July 2021 at Kuressaare, Saaremaa.

1. ENTRIES

All entries must be made in writing by an “electronic” entry form available in the site www.endurogp-registration.com. All other information relating to the riders, team, sponsor and the brand of the machine shall be completed.

The entry must include the entry fee payable by bank card, via a secured system. The entry form will be valid once the payment has been made.

Entry fees will be of 320 EUR/ Male Rider, 250 EUR/Women & Youth for the 3 days.

Entry fees for the Enduro Open Class will be of 120 EUR. The renting fees of the transponders are included in the entry fee.

All entries must be received before 25.06.2021 (21 days before the first day of the event). Or will be possible after this deadline with a fine of 50 EUR (30 EUR for Open World Cup) per entry. Local organiser is responsible of the National race entries.

All riders not affiliated to the FMNR must have their entry form endorsed by their own National FMN.

The riders must also sign the official signing-on document on site in order to appear on the official starting list.

2. TECHNICAL CONTROL AND REGISTRATION

Technical inspection will take place on Friday in the Paddock at Raiekivi tee, Kuressaare, Saaremaa according to the standard schedule.

During the registration, transponders, holders & mounting instructions will be distributed to participants who are not already in possession of the correct support. The cost of each holder is included in the transponder renting fee.

Each machine must be road legal for the country in which it is registered and comply with all requirements of the FIM Sporting Code and relevant Appendices. Intrinsic parts will be marked in accordance with Art. 062.23.1. A sound test will be carried out in accordance with the Technical Rules.

At the Administrative Control (for not permanent riders, wild card riders) the rider must submit his FIM Rider's Licence, Driving Licence, International Insurance Certificate (Green card).

At the Technical Inspection the rider must submit his motorcycling according to article 062.21 – 062.23, the original registration certificate of the bike (with frame number) and the vehicle registration plate, together with his helmet and body protector.



3. STARTING ORDER

The starting order and numbers will be in conformity with Art. 062.34.

4. COURSE

Day 1: Super Test (prologue). The first riders will start at 19h00.

The Super Test will be driven as a parallel race in 8-shape; two riders riding at the same time.

Day 2:

shall consist of: 4 laps of: 50 km which will include:
number of time checks per lap: 2
number of Extreme Tests (XT) : 1
number of Enduro Tests (ET): 1
number of Cross Tests (CT):: 1

At the end of Day 1, the Super Test will finish the course.

Day 3:

shall consist of: 4 laps of: 50 km which will include:
number of time checks per lap: 2
number of Cross Tests (CT): 1
number of Enduro Tests (ET): 1
number of Extreme Tests (XT): 1

At the end of Day 2, the Super Test will finish the course.

The location and the length of each test will be displayed in the Paddock at Raiekivi tee, Kuressaare, Saaremaa from 14 July 2021 at 14h00 - at least 48 hours in advance.

5. PENALTIES

Penalties to be in accordance with Art 062.64.

6. HEADQUARTERS AND FIM RACE DIRECTION MEETINGS

The headquarters for the event will be at Hotel Rütli (Pargi 12, Kuressaare, Saaremaa) and the office will be open from 14 July 2021 at 18h00.

The FIM Race Direction meetings will be held according to the standard schedule.



7. PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The Prize-Giving Ceremony will take place each day in the start area immediately after the final classified rider of the day has arrived at the finish. Awards will be presented to the first three riders of each category/class. **Riders must present themselves in their racing equipment or team apparel.**

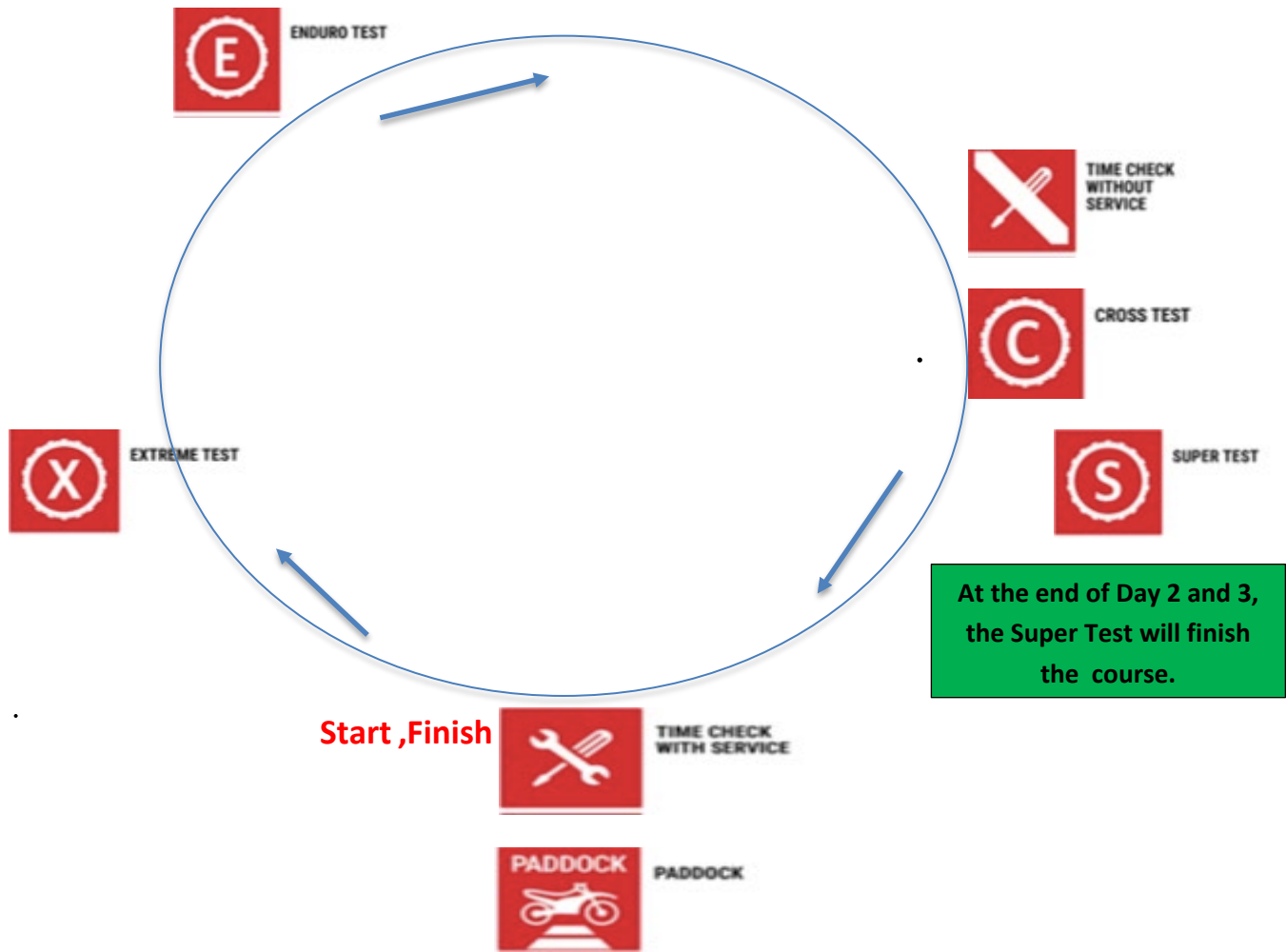

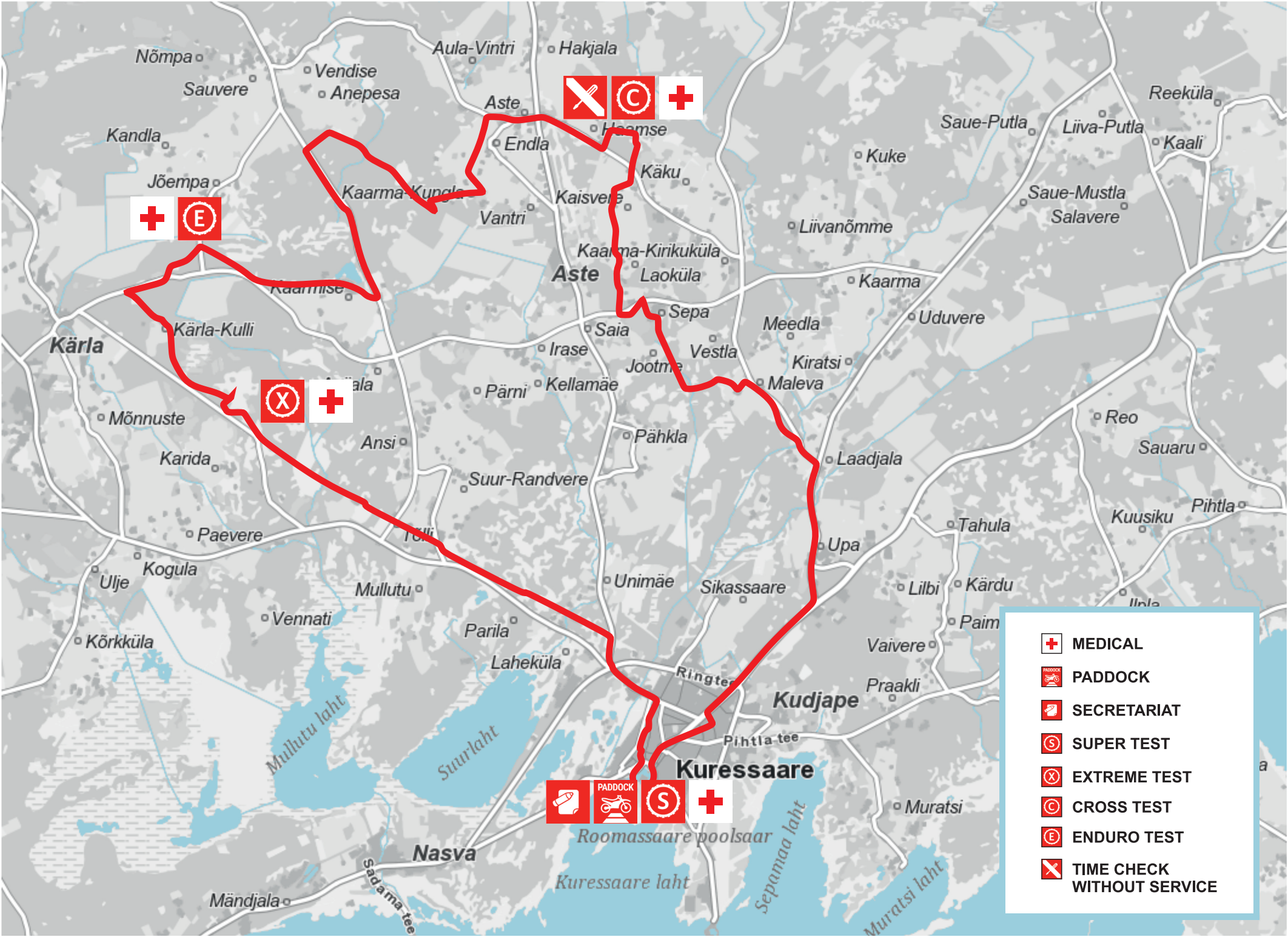

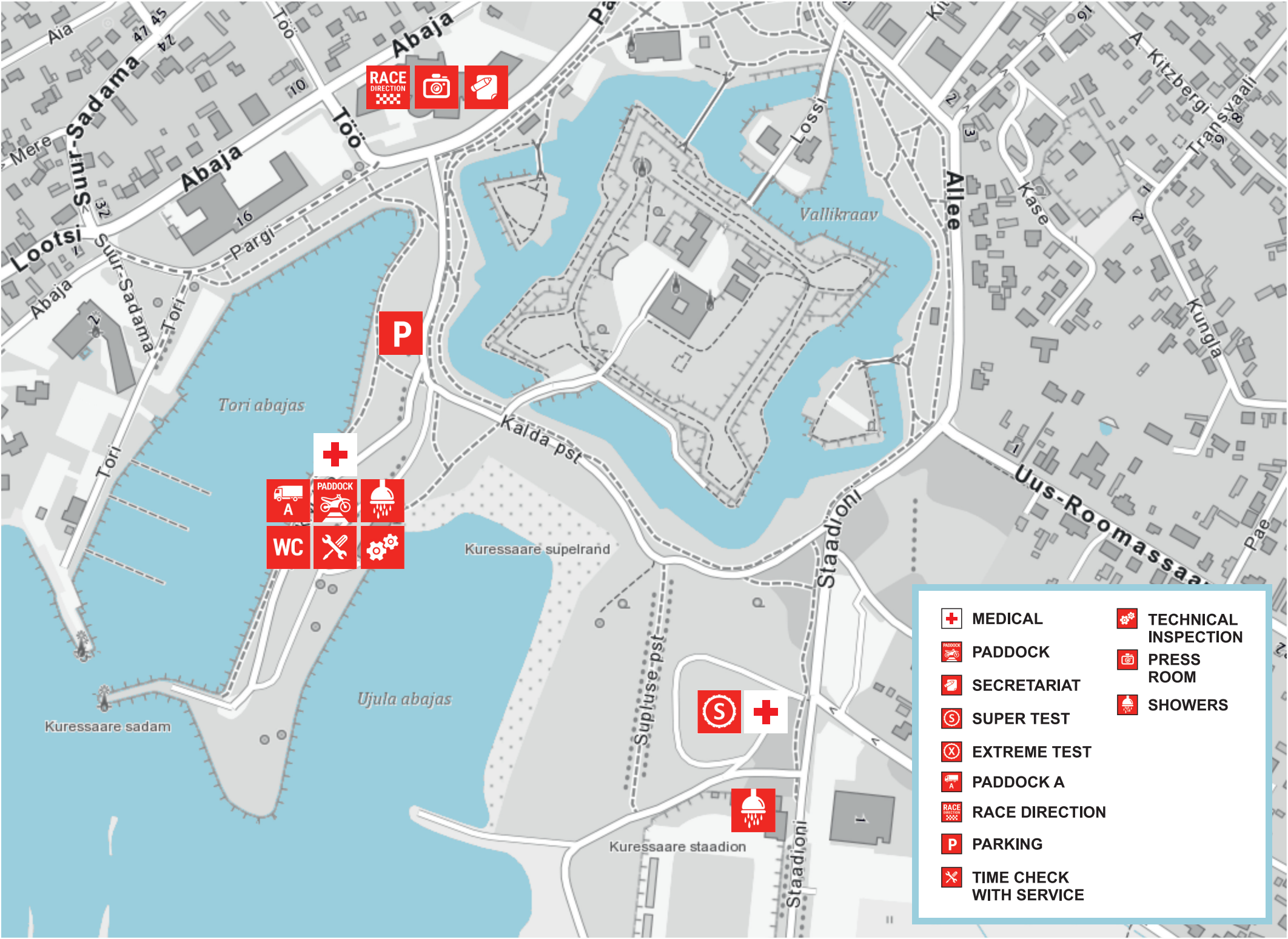
